

Where do your dollars go?

ACLU of Nebraska

- \$25 allows us to testify on one of the nearly 100 bills that impact civil liberties each year.
- \$50 allows us to do a "Know Your Rights" presentation to a classroom or community group.
- \$500 covers the cost of a basic legal proceeding in one of the dozens of cases we take on each year, including the case to bring the Freedom to marry to all Nebraskans.

The Arc of Nebraska

- \$1 per week provides a meal for a person with developmental disabilities with their state senator.
- \$5 per week provides for one family to attend a training sponsored by The Arc.
- \$50 provides an opportunity for a person with a developmental disability to attend a conference.
