ACLU of Nebraska

- \$50 pays for 1,000 "Know Your Rights" brochures for community members.
- \$100 a month funds our "Know Your Rights" training sessions. (\$1200)
- \$75 a month provides informational sessions for DACA Youth on current immigration policy. (\$900)

Angels Among Us

- \$10 per month will pay a utility bill. (\$120)
- \$18 per month for one year will pay a car bill. (\$216)
- \$25 a month will pay a mortgage payment. (\$300)
- \$100 a month will support a family for two months. (\$1200)

The Arc of Nebraska

- \$14.75 per week goes to help reach out to 1500 families to update them about issues in the disability community. (\$177)
- \$244.79 goes to help provide trainings on issues from navigating Medicare to improving workplace accessibility.

The Archway

- \$2 per week provides a scholarship for a group of 26 4th graders to tour the Archway and learn about Nebraska history. (\$104)
- \$5 per week helps defray the cost of printed material that describes Nebraska's unique role in the building of America for distribution to Archway visitors. (\$260)
- \$10 per week provides a new set of tables and chairs for use by students and community groups in the Archway's Event Room. (\$520)
- \$20 per week provides sponsorship for one of the Archway's popular Soda Fountain Sundae musical programs. (\$1,040)

Audubon Nebraska

- \$1 per week could provide an insect net, magnifier, and other tools for students to use exploring our ecosystem throughout the year. (\$52)
- \$2 per week is the cost of one pair of binoculars for use by students and adults in various citizen-science and discovery learning opportunities throughout the year. (\$104)
- \$5 per week could cover expenses for one acre's worth of native seed mix. When restoring new areas and improving existing habitat, these seeds brings the mix of

grasses and wildflowers that the birds, bugs, and other wildlife need for food and shelter. (\$260)

- \$10 per week could cover the cost of burning 25 acres of our native prairie. This is an authentic and crucial part of conserving a flourishing native plant diversity at our 3,000+ acres of protected habitat in Nebraska. (\$520)
- \$20 per week is the cost of a week-long camp for a group of Nebraska students, who will get to fully immerse in hands-on, discovery-based learning at one of our education centers. (\$1040)

Autism Center of Nebraska, Inc. (ACN)

- \$1,000 supports an ARTreach exhibition at a venue in a Nebraska city or town. Averaging 23 shows a year at various locales around the region, exhibitions from MONA are seen by 28,800 annually.

NALHD – Nebraska Association of Local Health Directors
